This means the Optics routine isn't getting a response from the MCC, I'm trying to figure out how Optics addresses MCC, the IP address for MCC (Alakai) has been changed and it looks like Optics can't handle that change - as if it addresses using an IP address instead of the alakai host name. These routines are the same for CHIP too, and CHIP is having the same

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problem.
