Tested Access Grid with Bunny.

Grid gurus suggested we use "bridge" instead of "multicast"

That worked.

Bunny couldn't see her own image, but with "Camera 1" clicked (checked) in both "display video" and "transmit video" local image is displayed and transmitted over to Boulder. That menu is displayed by clicking on the camera icon in the toolbar.

Audio is selected the same way, by clicking on the boxes next to the mic and speaker icons in the toolbar.

Remote video came up behind the small InSors window by clicking on the camera icon in the window (not the one in the toolbar) next to the remote source line once it appears (when remote site connects) and then clicking on the remote camera (HAO-Kansas in this trial).

Microphone worked OK when held nearer the speaker, rather low when left in place beneath the monitor. Speakers caused mild feedback and audio was a bit soft when set at volumes that didn't cause feedback.

Headset was much better, earbuds will not be as goofy.

If one has time to set things up by crawling under the desk behind the PC, one could plug in one of the headsets with the integrated mic -- there is an extension for the speaker/headphones but none for the mic -- one won't have to mess with the microphone if that is an issue. Turn things off by clicking the appropriate buttons or turn off everything by exiting room.
