This board connects to the LCVR, in the recent past the frequent CHIP crashes appeared to be related to Alakai waiting for the LCVR to retune to a different

wavelength so that older problem may be fixed now also, time will tell.

The symptoms of this recent problem were that the GUI monitor didn't come up and the Kii VxWorks boot screen showed a "bus error", and alakai couldn't be pinged. Will try to get data through the clouds.
