Unable to open upper dome this morning. The input shaft to the transmission turns but the output shaft does not. This looks like the same problem we had several years ago - a pin locking one of the gears to its shaft sheared. The transmission will need to be removed, disassembled and the pin replaced. The battery for the orange ladder is also dead, so it will have to be charged before I can start removing the transmission. Most likely the work will take a least all of today and maybe longer, so no observations except PSPT until the transmission is repaired.
