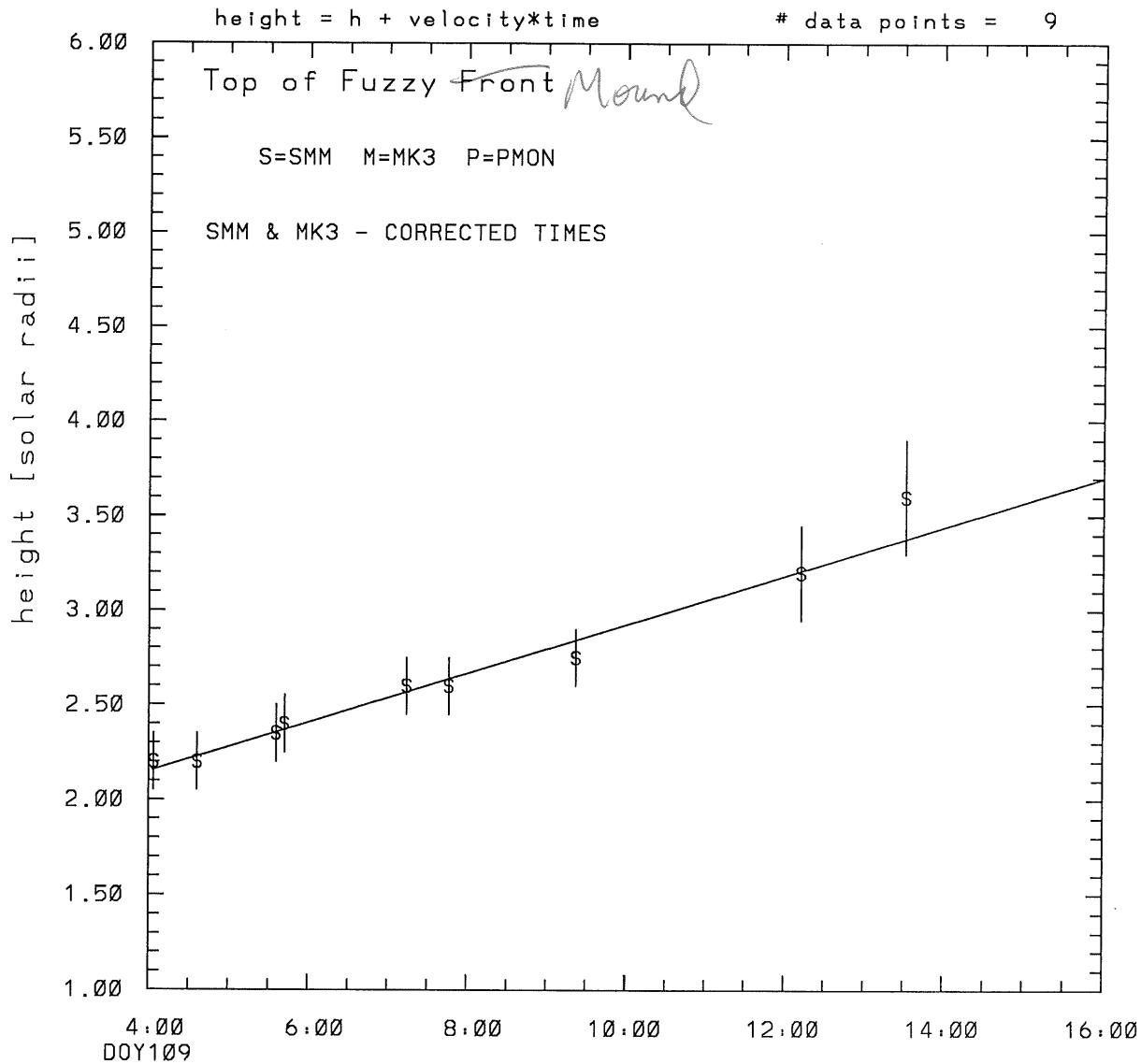
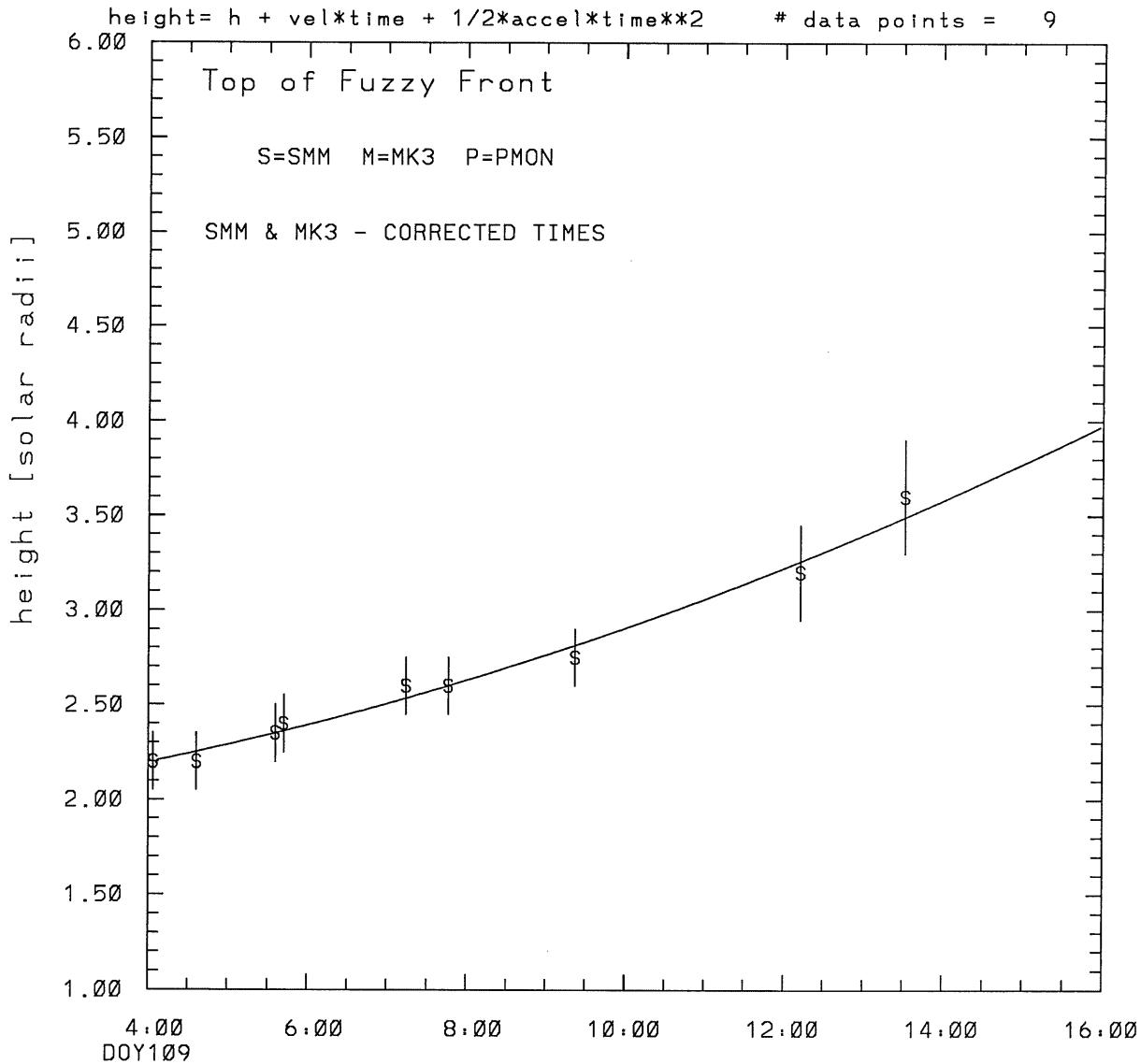


SMM C/P 1980 DOY109 105 +/- 0 degrees



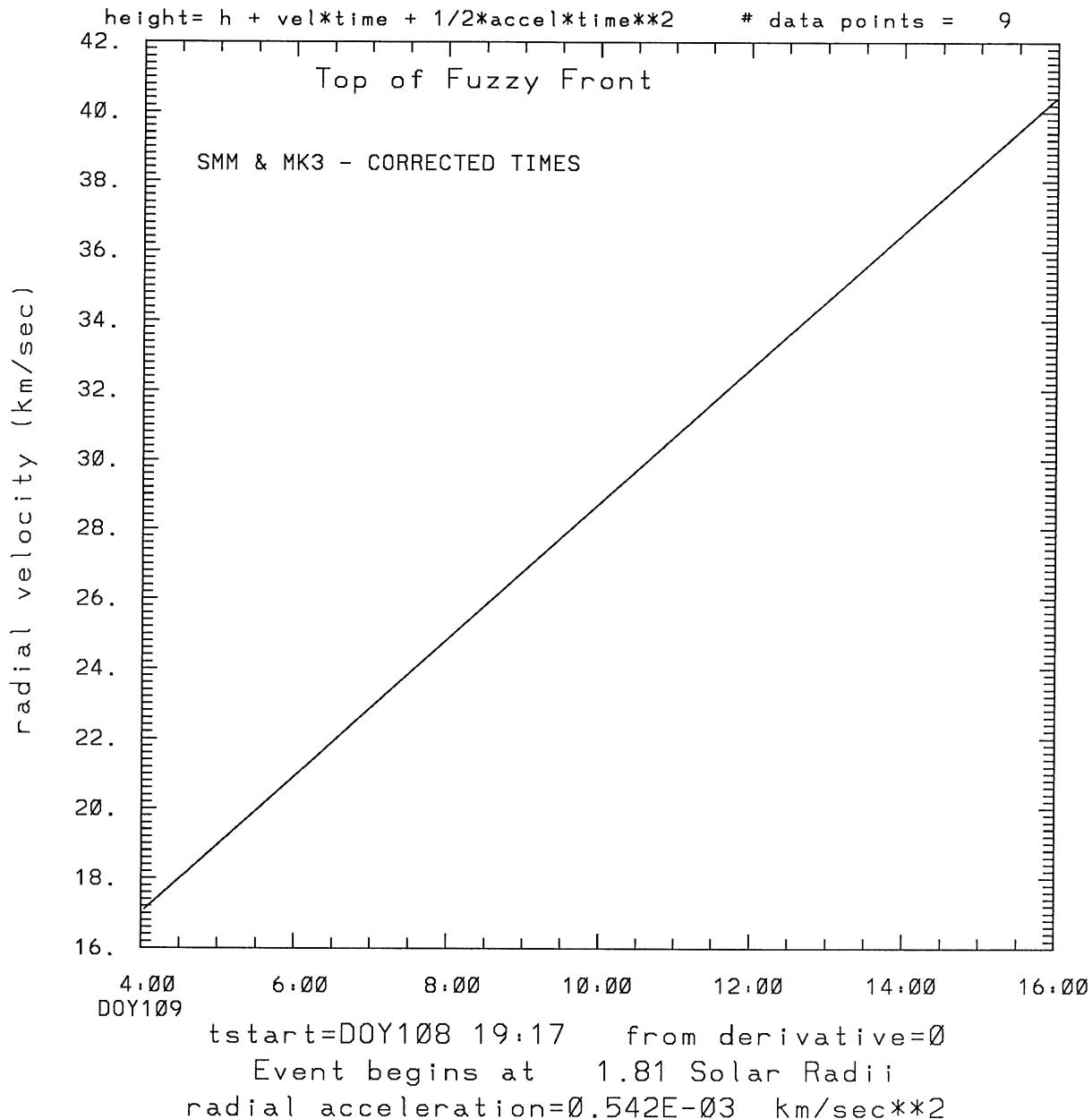
