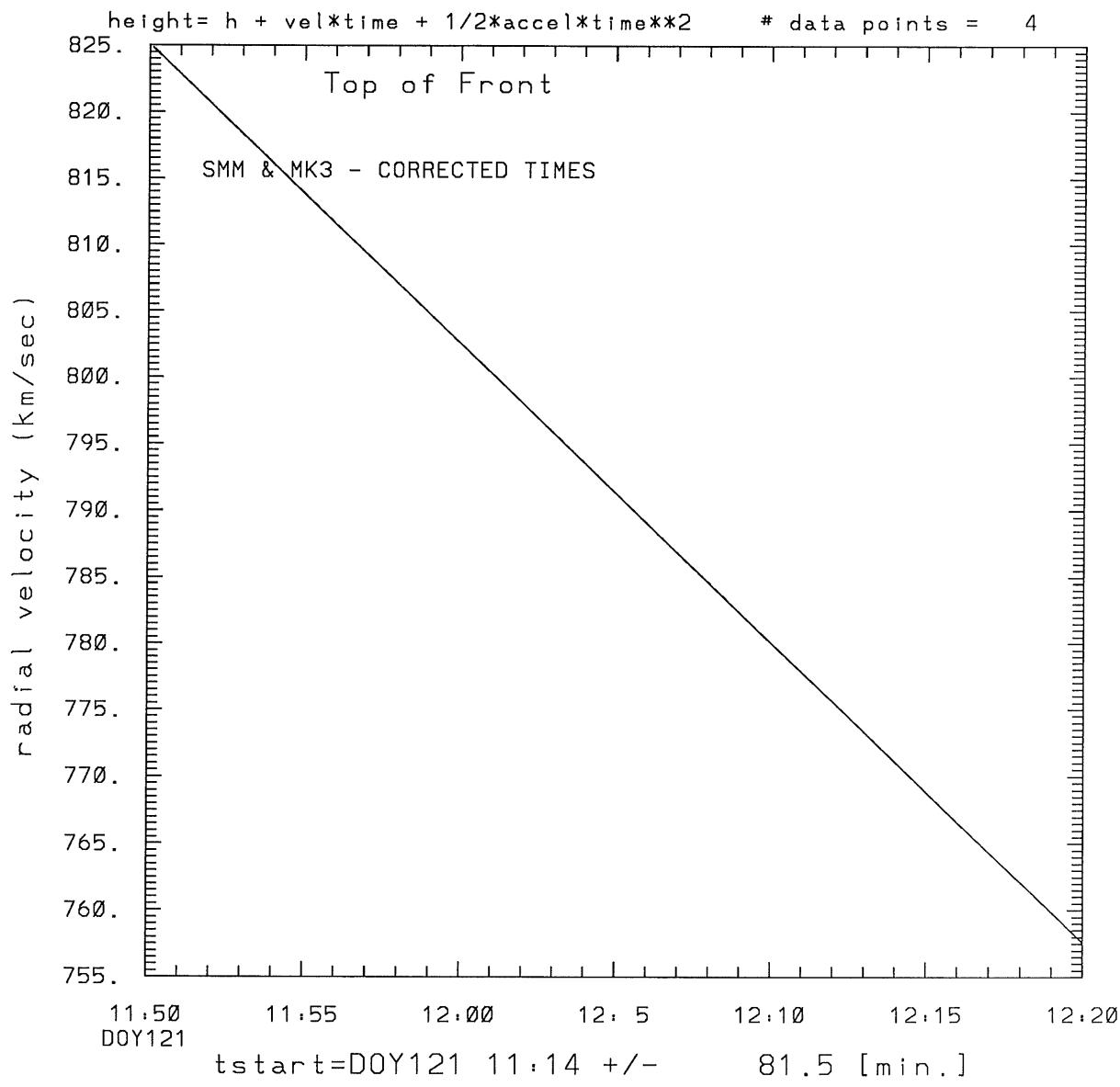

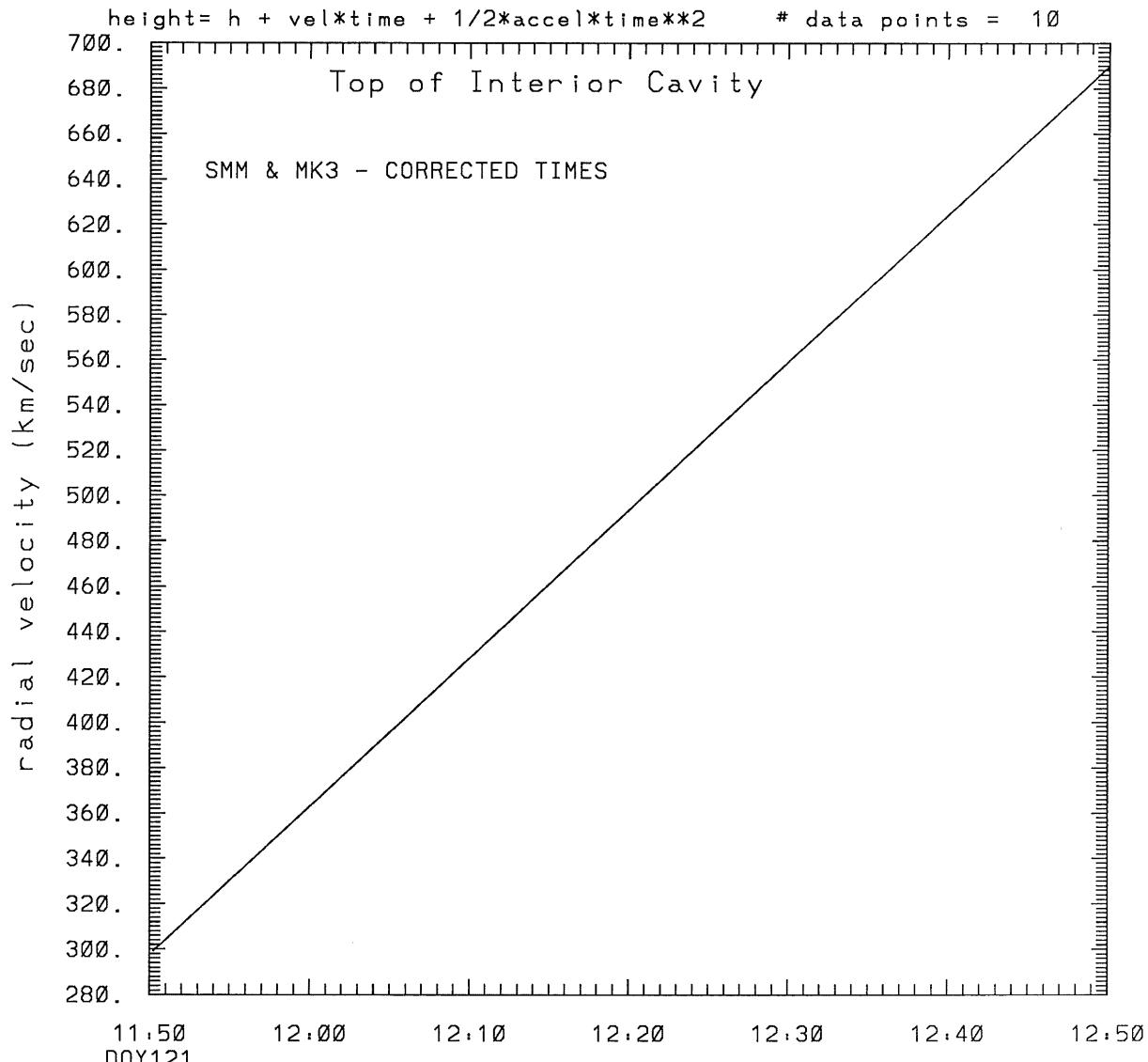


SMM C/P 1980 DOY121 72 +/- 0 degrees
