SMM C/P 1980 DOY121 40 +/- 0 degrees



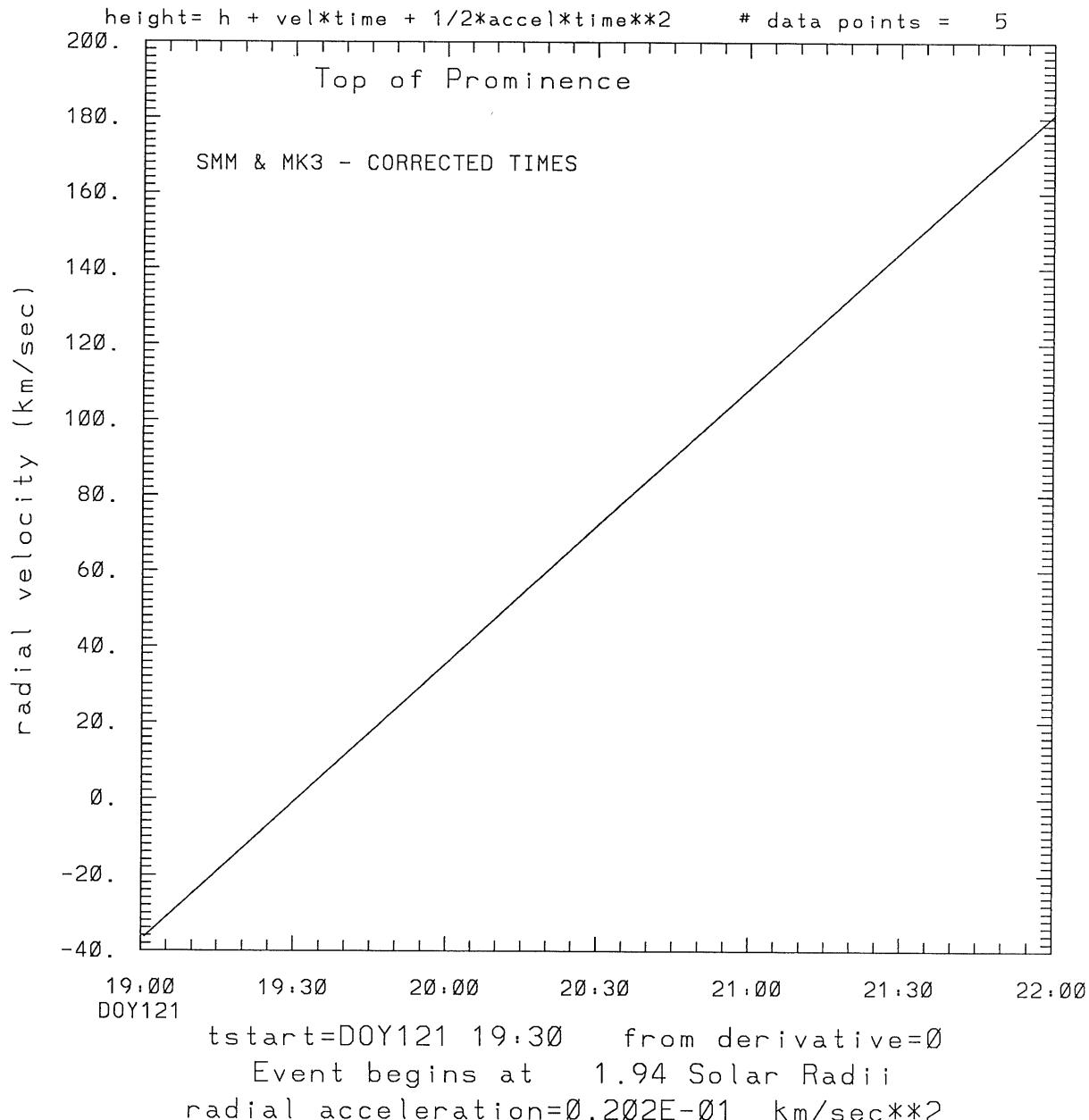


SMM C/P 1980 DOY121 40 +/- 0 degrees
