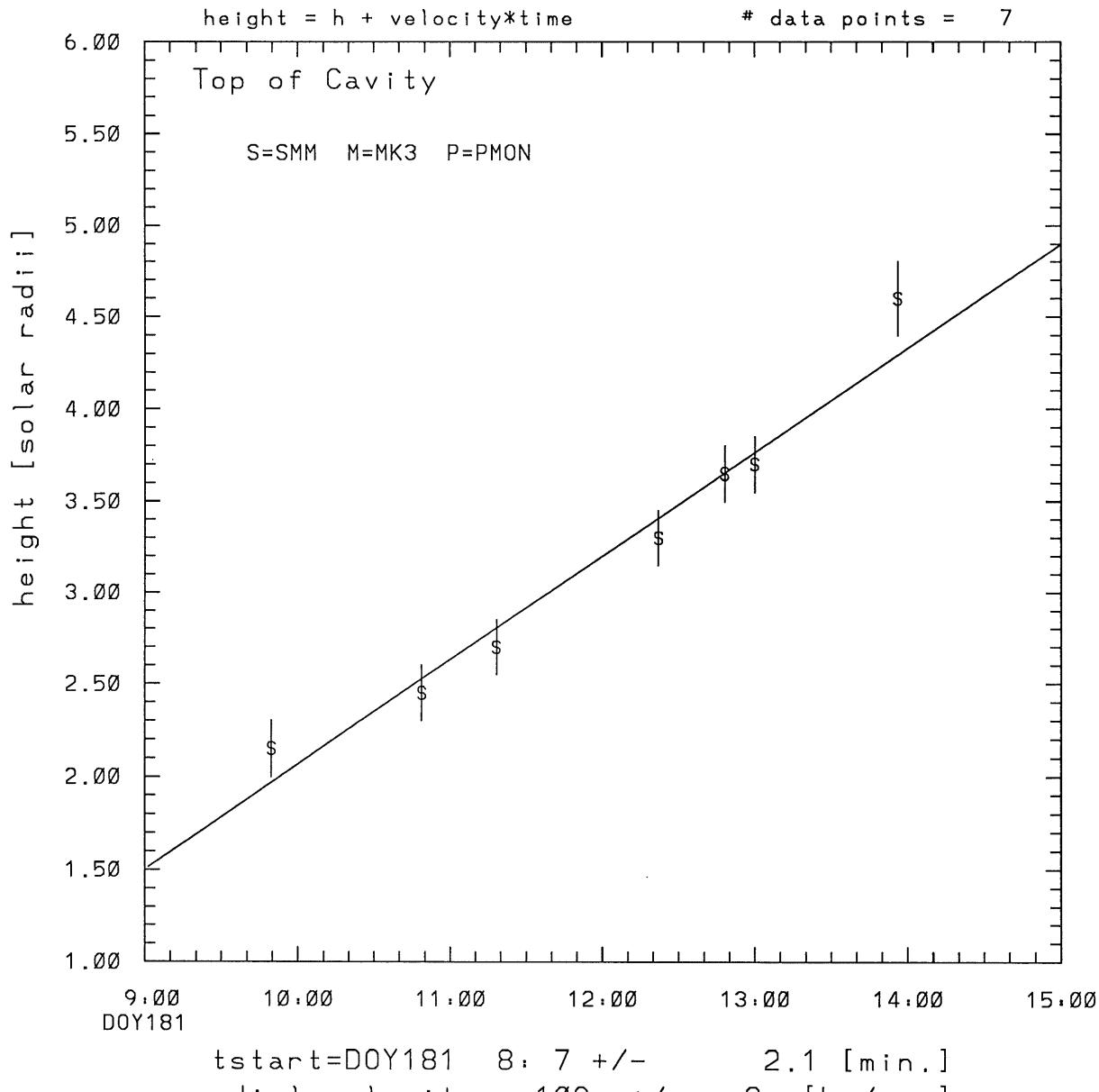
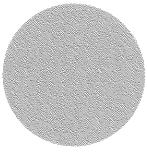
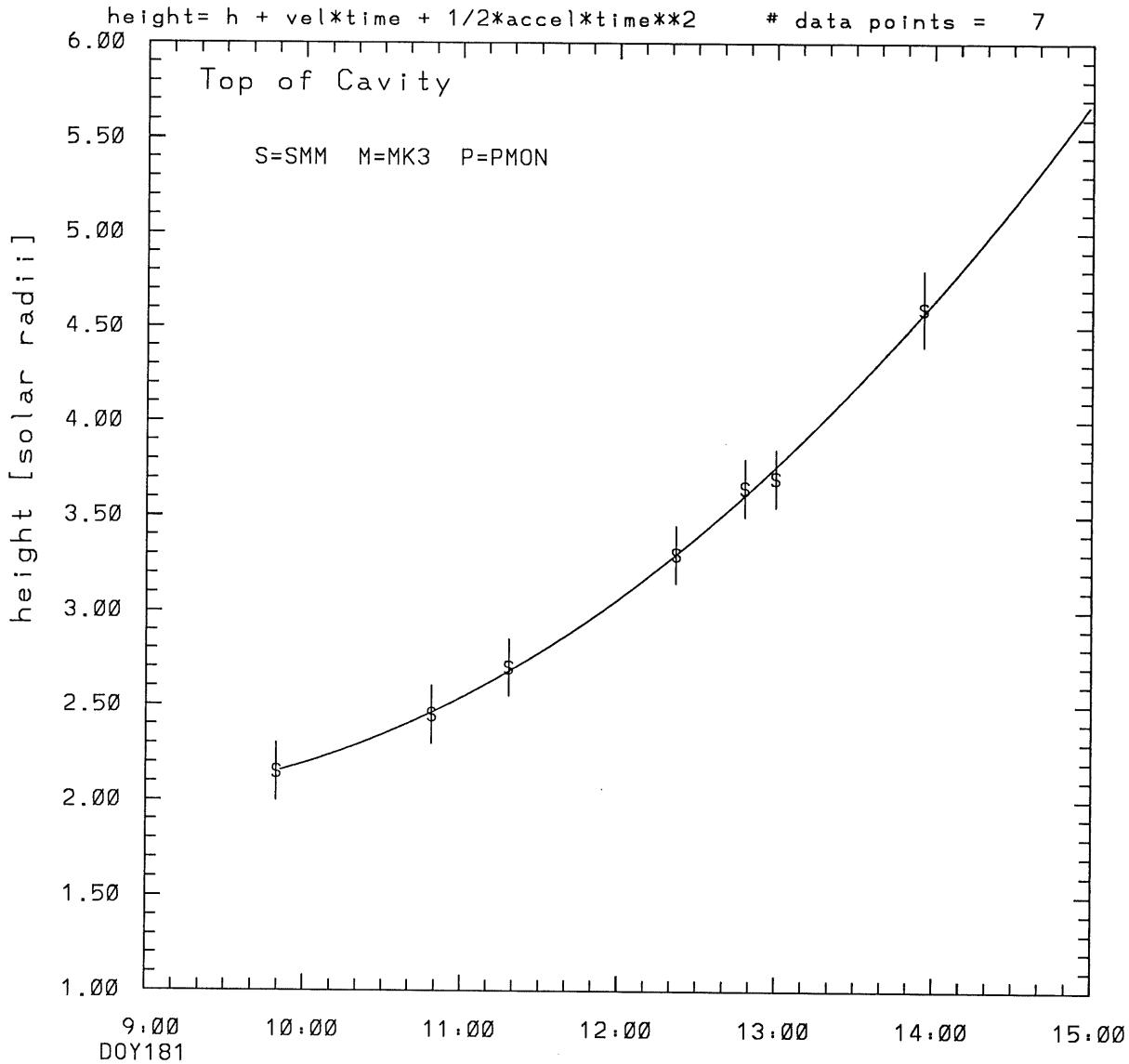


SMM C/P 1984 DOY181 230 +/- 0 degrees



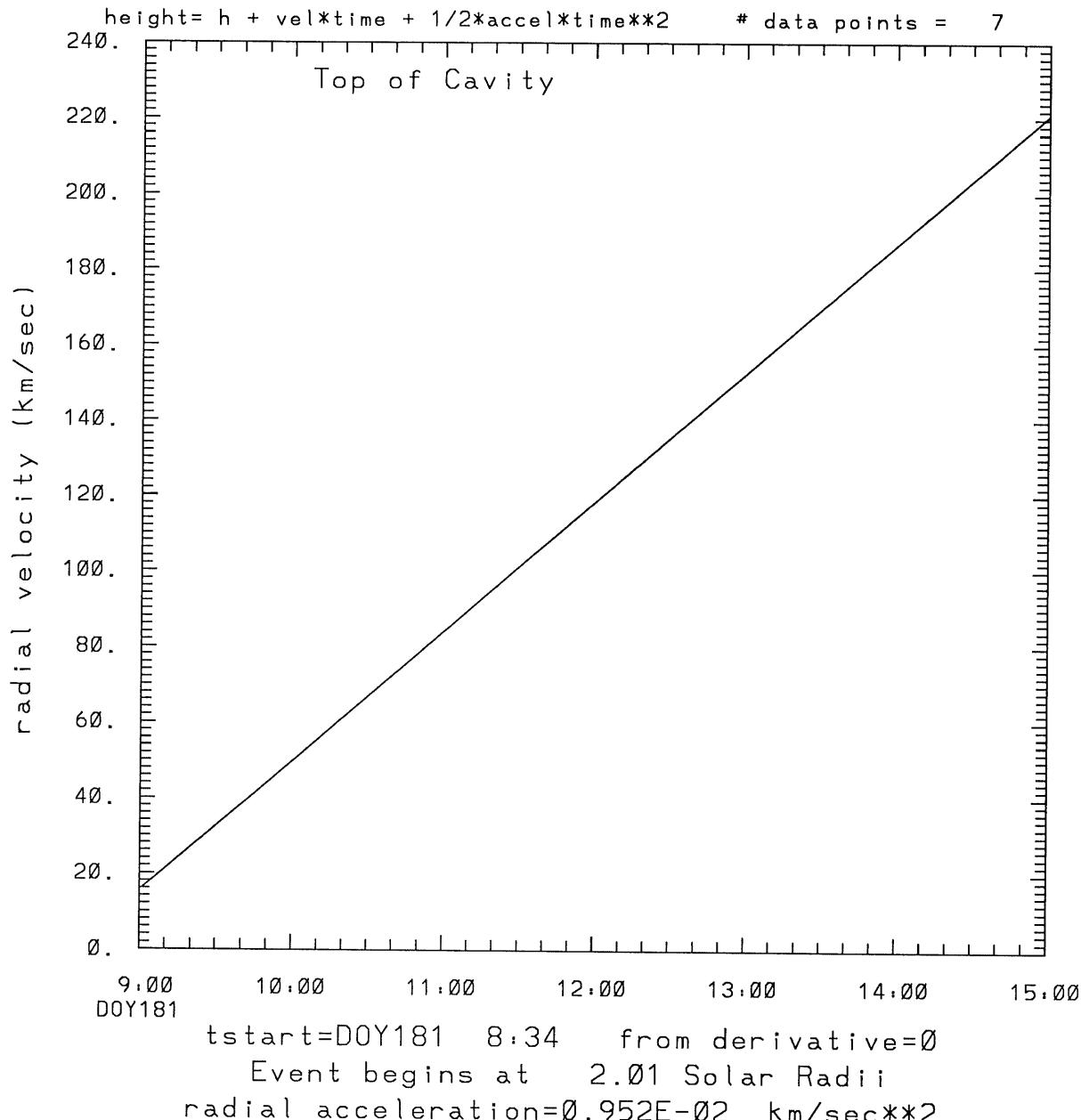
