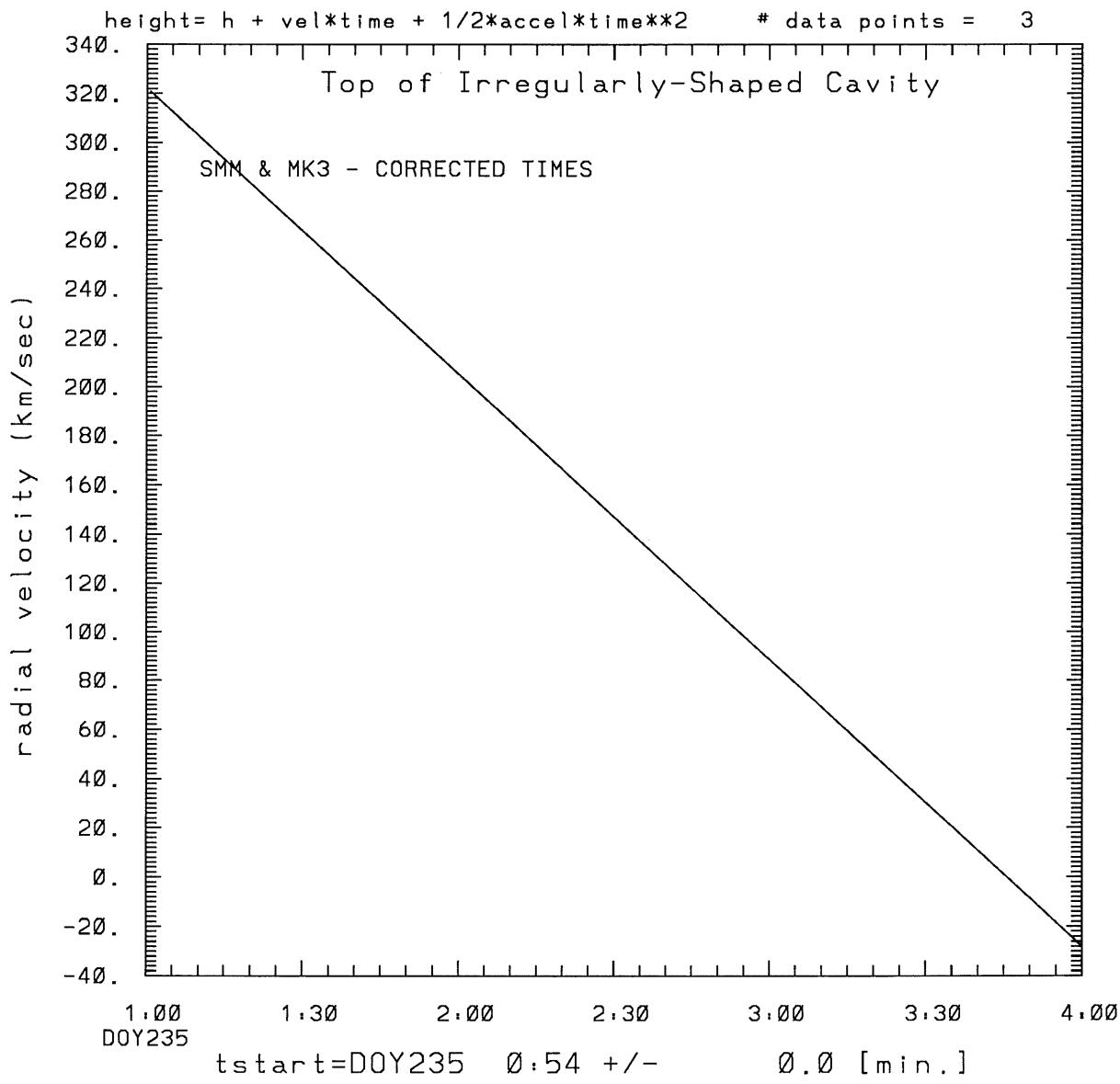

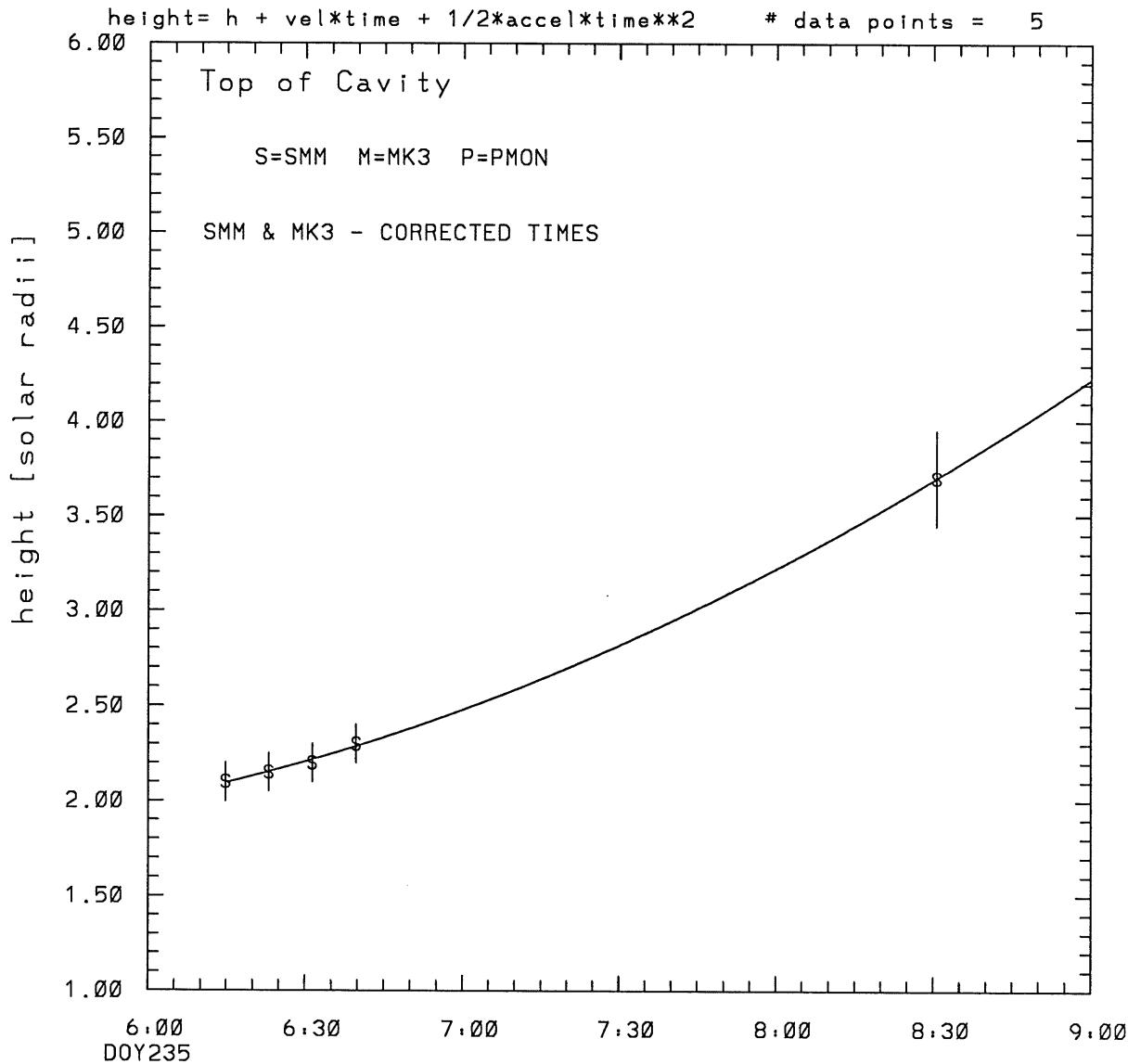


SMM C/P 1988 DOY235 104 +/- 0 degrees



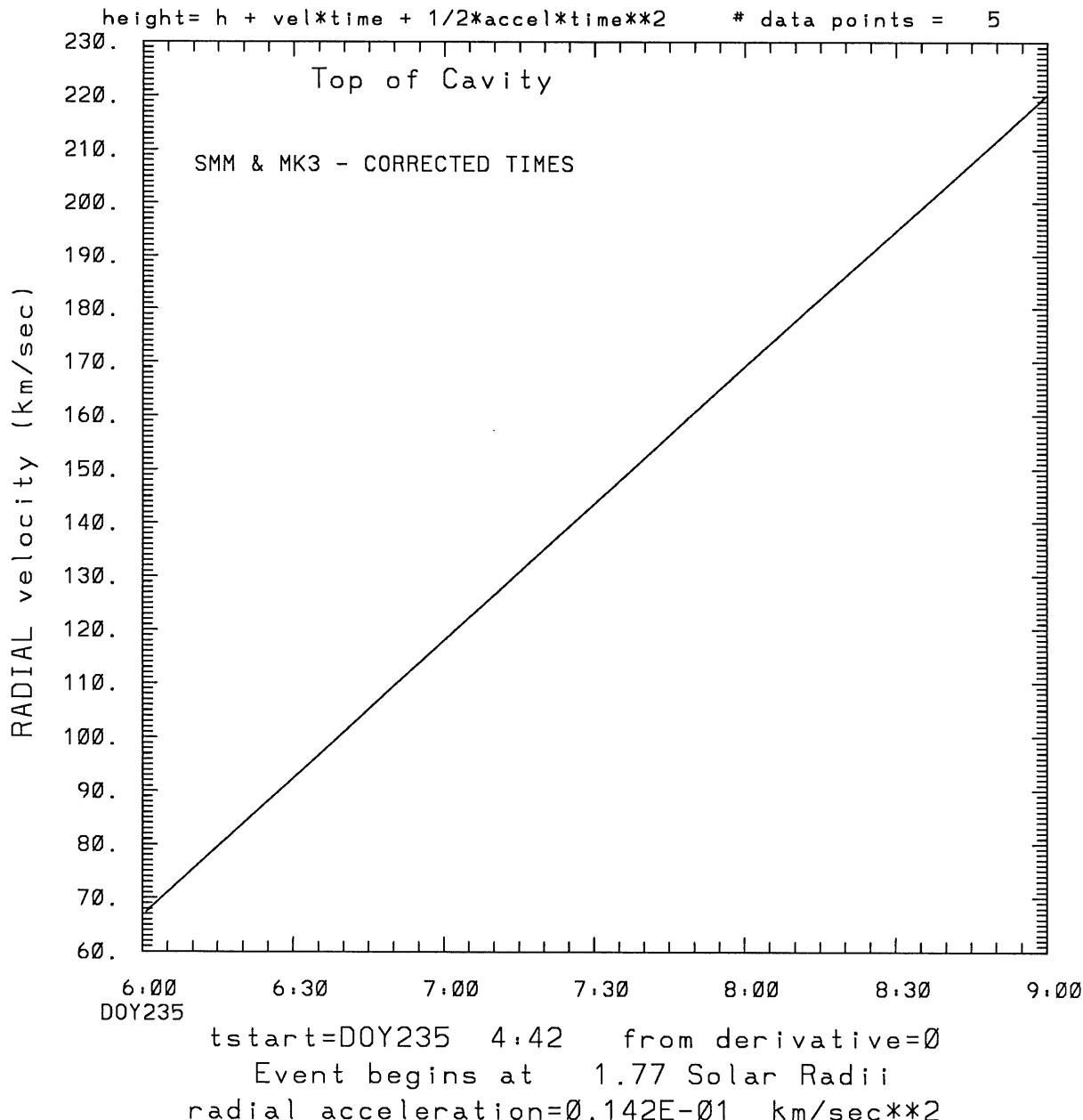
