Very rainy, thunderstorms all night, looks like power went out at least once, wind=20 mph from the SE, temp=43 F. No observing today.

Some water leaked in under the door since the new slab is at the same level as the inside floor, but it was a lot less water than I expected to see, I mopped it up. I will continue to look around for other problems to fix.
