On the media converters there are green LEDs for each side of the converter, the FX (fiber side) was green but the UTP (copper cable side) LED wasn't lit, and the network switch under the monitor area didn't show a connection to the converter via lit LEDs. I'll inform GONG and ask for some patch cables to allow use of the Gigabit media converters they recently sent us, there is no spare media converter until I get those cables.
