It looks like the program stalled right when it tried to start a calibration around 1924 UT. The KCC monitor GUI (top) was unresponsive to the mouse, I think this is related to the new type of crashes we've been seeing for the last few days. I checked and reseated the mouse connections back to the KCC video board (Vigra) but problem still existed, cycled KCC power and KCC monitor went dark but barrel turned normally to normal start position. Tried reseating the video cable on KCC video board w/o improvements. Turned off KCC and reseated the Vigra video board, upon turning the main KCC power on everything started like usual, problem fixed for now, hopefully it was just dirty contacts for the Vigra board.

We need to log any error messages in the Console window and the state of the Status window until we can understand this problem better. It looks like the crashes happen while writing data and that the "Watchdog Reset" error messages that we sometimes see are related to hardware (RAM, HDD, CPU, etc) problems. Alice is setting up Kii to write data to a different place to see if that helps, maybe /local/d is the new HDD and the problem, that's where data goes normally.
