Thank you for expressing interest in the possibility of locating SOLIS at your site. As you know, NSO is undertaking a comprehensive relocation process to transition from its historic sites in Sunspot New Mexico and Tucson Arizona to its new locations in Maui Hawaii, and Boulder Colorado. A major aspect of this evolution is the relocation of the SOLIS instrument package from Arizona to a new site.
